Integrated Health Home *A New Service for Better Coordinated Holistic Healthcare*

What is an Integrated Health Home (IHH)?

- IHH is not a “home,” but a way of caring for your whole health.
- An IHH healthcare team will work with you to meet your overall health needs. This team includes a Care Coordinator, Social Services Specialists and a Nurse Care Manager.

Where does IHH get referrals from?

- Medical and Mental Health Providers
- Social Service Providers
- Educational Facilities
- Law Enforcement
- Family and Friends

How can it help me?

- Achieve your health goals through partnership with your existing healthcare team.
- Focus on your choices, your strengths, good health and wellness.
- Provide support services for you and your family members.
- Arrange transportation to healthcare appointments if needed.
- In addition to the same behavioral health provider you have now, you also will have a primary care provider and access to peer support services.

Who can receive services?

To meet eligibility, you must have two or more Chronic Conditions, such as, but not limited to:

- Alcohol or Substance Abuse
- Mental Health Condition
- Cardiovascular Disease (e.g., Diabetes)
- Respiratory Disease (e.g., Asthma)
- Complex Trauma
- SED (Severe Emotional Disturbance)
